We are also very thankful for the community here at Tyndale, and for the way that so many supported us during this difficult time. We still don't know what was ailing Cathie--the doctors are just saying it was an unknown infection. We are just so thankful to know that our lives are in God's hands, and we know that this was neither unknown nor unforeseen by Him!
